



# **Rich** broadcasting **INTERNSHIP PROGRAM**

Rich Broadcasting is proud to offer radio internship opportunities. The goal of this program is to provide college students with meaningful and practical work experience in all aspects of the radio industry so they can acquire the knowledge, understanding, and confidence needed to pursue a career in broadcasting.

### ***How it works...***

Under the supervision and direction of the Program Director, interns can expect to: assist with writing, researching, and updating news and feature coverage; edit and produce web content; participate in station marketing/promotional events/remotes; perform light clerical duties and assist staff members. Intern assignments may vary day-to-day.

### ***Requirements...***

- Students must be currently attending an accredited college/university and have achieved junior or senior status.
- Students majoring in journalism, broadcasting or communications are preferred, but other majors will be considered for the program.
- Students must have good computer skills, excellent written and verbal communication abilities and knowledge of current events.
- A 3.0 GPA or above is recommended.
- Students must receive credit from their academic institution to be able to participate in the program.
- All internships are unpaid.

### ***Sessions:***

SPRING: January to May – Internship opportunities will be posted mid-November

SUMMER: June to August – Internships opportunities will be posted mid-April

FALL: September to December – Internships opportunities will be posted mid-July

### ***To Be Considered...***

- Students are required to complete a Rich Broadcasting Application. Applications will only be considered for posted “open” internship opportunities. Unsolicited applications will not be accepted.
- Provide at least one letter of recommendation, a copy of current college transcript and a writing sample.
- Provide a letter indicating certification of college academic credit.
- Must be able to meet the minimum time commitment required for the internship.
